## 9th & 10th GRADE BLOCK CHOICES 2024-25 (ver 8.12.24)

The Elements of these sessions will include small group discussion, videos, activities, instruction, service, prayer, testimonials, etc.

PLEASE NOTE: EACH TEEN MUST CHOOSE A TOTAL OF FIVE OF THE BLOCKS LISTED. The first FOUR blocks (in red) are REQUIRED to be completed by the end of 10<sup>th</sup> grade. So, IF YOU ARE IN 9<sup>th</sup> GRADE you only need to complete TWO of these required blocks this year PLUS THREE other blocks (electives). IF YOU ARE IN 10<sup>th</sup> GRADE you must complete ALL FOUR of the required blocks PLUS ONE other block (electives). (Exception: If you have already completed Eucharist, Creed and/or Case for a Creator blocks, you only need to complete the required blocks you have not completed, plus electives to total FIVE blocks). IF YOU ARE CONFUSED, DON'T WORRY! THIS WILL ALL BE EXPLAINED IN DETAIL AT THE PARENT/TEEN MEETINGS.

BREAKING OPEN THE CREED (Required) - Do you believe in God, the Father Almighty, creator of Heaven & earth and in Jesus Christ, his only son, our Lord? How so? Do you know what "consubstantial with the Father" means? This block will help you understand the words you are saying when you pray the Creed and what they mean in today's world.

<u>A CASE for a CREATOR & A CASE for CHRIST (Required)</u> - Discussions on the existence of GOD and that JESUS is not only a real person, but the SON OF GOD. What is the evidence ... why should we believe?

<u>EUCHARIST: GOD'S GIFT OF SELF (Required)</u> - Learn to understand the Eucharist in a deeper way. This block will reflect on the meaning of Eucharist using scripture, videos, activities, and connecting service & justice. Of course, Eucharist is receiving Communion at Mass today...but it is also a meal...you will learn about who Jesus dined with, the miracle of feeding five thousand and what that means today. Then discover why the Eucharist is the "source & summit" (summit means highest point) of our Catholic faith.

WHO IS THIS HOLY SPIRIT ANYWAY? (Required-10<sup>th</sup> Grade) Learn about the third person of the Holy Trinity. Discover what the Holy Spirit has to do with each of us today. We will also explore what the Holy Spirit has to do with creation, Jesus' life, Confirmation... and more.

<u>ADVENT-THE MESSIAH IS COMING: Waiting in Joyful Hope</u> - Using the main characters in the Advent/Christmas story, we will explore the season of Advent, the role that Mary, Joseph, and John the Baptist play in these stories & its meaning for us.

We will share Jesus in our world through a class project and/or by caroling at a nursing home or to shut ins. (If you choose this block, you must attend but singing is optional).

<u>HEAVEN</u>, <u>HELL & IMAGES of GOD</u> - Heaven is a big deal because you are an eternal being. Hell is a big deal because you are an eternal being. Allow Scripture, Literature, Art & Movies to bring you to a deeper understanding of life, death, afterlife, and how our image of God shapes us.

LOOK AT LENT: We Journey to the Cross - Lent is a season that leads us to the Cross of Jesus. Learn about Jesus being tempted in the desert, the Last Supper, his betrayal, trial & death. Lent is also a season of prayer, fasting & almsgiving... what does that mean and how can participation in those actions change us?

NEW FOLLOWING JESUS - Learn about the Apostles (and disciples) that walked with Jesus during his life on earth. Learn some of their stories as they walked with Jesus and witnessed his miracles, suffering, death & resurrection. Also learn about some of the Saints and modern-day faithful followers of Jesus. We will also discuss what it means for US to be followers today.

NEW- WHAT I REALLY WANT TO KNOW... Are there things that you don't understand about your Catholic faith, the bible, the teachings or Traditions of the Church? In this block <u>YOU NEED TO COME PREPARED TO ASK THE</u>

QUESTIONS on the first week. We will try to answer all your questions as best we can by consulting pastors or having guest speakers if needed during the next 2 weeks.

NEW- DISCIPLESHIP NIGHTS - (Only offered at the Seton Center on the Lourdes Campus) Join us for one month as a block but you can come every month (or when it fits into your schedule) if you want to continue sharing faith, fellowship & fun on these youth ministry nights. Note: Offered on 3 Mondays each month and you must attend all 3 Mondays of the month you choose as a block.
